

BASIC RULES FOR TEXAS BAPTIST COLLEGE STUDENTS

1. All students are required to attend Sunday School, Sunday morning and evening services, and Wednesday night services. The only students not required to attend all services at Longview Baptist Temple are those who live in the area, who have been faithful members of, and are attending another fundamental, Bible-believing church before entering college. (25)
 2. Everyone on campus is required to attend the daily chapel services. Off campus students attending even just one class for the day must attend chapel. (25)
 3. Tardiness to services and classes will not be permitted. Student will be considered absent when arriving more than ten minutes late for any required service or class. (2)
 4. Students are required to go soul winning every week. Soul winning is defined as witnessing to unsaved people. They must visit at least four hours and present the gospel to at least five persons each week. (5)
 5. All students are assigned a bus route or AFC ministry. Students are required to fulfill their ministry responsibilities unless acceptable arrangement has been made and approved by the head of their ministry. (10) Ladies do not go soul winning or on bus visitation alone. (5)
 6. Students may not preach in other churches without Administrative approval. (10)
 7. Upon receiving correspondence or hearing announcements from the faculty or administrative authorities the student must respond within 24 hours. (5)
 8. Participation in activities which are not in harmony with the Christian life (such as, but not limited to, reading or looking at questionable material, use of tobacco, drinking alcoholic beverages, gambling, playing cards, dancing, attending movies, attending plays and theater events, use of profanity, abuse of drugs) will be dealt with directly by the President of the College. (5 – EXPULSION)
 9. A student's place of employment is subject to administrative approval. (5)
 10. Students may only listen to and watch college approved audio and video. (5 - 50)
 11. Students must be honest. Cheating, lying, and stealing will not be tolerated. (25 to expulsion)
 12. No firearms or lethal weapons are allowed on campus. (35)
 13. Cell phones must be turned off in classrooms, in chapel, and all other church services or meetings. (3)
 14. General rules pertaining to specific areas must be adhered to. Such as, but not limited to: dress standards, dormitory rules, dating guidelines, vehicle requirements, classroom rules, and dining hall rules. (2 – 10)
 15. Student's must tithe and give a weekly offering. (5)
 16. Students are not to touch members of the opposite sex unless they are married to each other. (5 - 50)
 17. A student's dating activity is subject to approval by the parents of both the boy and the girl, the deans, and the Preacher. (5)
 18. Every student is required to fill out and turn in an Activity Report (50 – reduced to an offense violation when turned in) each Monday.
 19. The wives and children of off-campus students must abide by the same rules that govern the student body.
 20. If at any time a student manifests a detrimental influence or spirit of controversy on the campus, or engenders a spirit contrary to the purpose and principles for which the college stands, he or she is subject to expulsion even though they may not have broken any specific rule or regulation.
